SERMON NOTES

Interruptions As Opportunities:
An Opportunity to Delve Below the Surface
Mark 1:21-28

Jesus’ ministry, like our own lives, was a constant series of interruptions! The Gospel of Mark records many of them for us. From the example of Jesus, we can learn to view interruptions as opportunities to help people and glorify God.

- ◆ Interruptions can be annoying to us, but they also may also give us an opportunity to delve beneath the surface of a person’s behavior.
- ◆ Why people do what they do is often more important than what they do.
- ◆ Interruptions will sometimes give you the opportunity to address a person’s greatest needs—and to turn them toward Jesus!
