Interruptions As Opportunities:
"An Opportunity to Minister to the Unseen"
Mark 5:24-34

As Jesus was on his way to save the life of a little girl, he was "interrupted" by the sudden flow of healing power from his body. A woman desperate for healing after many years of illness had secretly reached out in faith to touch his robe. Jesus' loving response is a great lesson to us about ministering to the unseen.

- ♦ Not everyone who needs attention is willing to ask for it.
- ♦ There are many "invisible" and forgotten people all around us.
- They are often the people who need our attention the most.
- As you learn to see the unseen, hear the unheard, and value the unwanted, don't be surprised if they teach you lessons about deep faith.
