Christian Sacrifices - Hebrews 13:11-16

The Old Testament sacrificial system involved the killing of animals. But when Jesus died on the cross as the perfect, once-for-all sacrifice for sins, animal sacrifices were no longer necessary for those who put their trust in Him. But Scripture reveals there are still sacrifices which Christians should make to God.
