THE BREAD

Pastor: *For I received from the Lord what I also passed on to you:*

People: ***The Lord Jesus, on the night he was betrayed, took bread,***

Pastor: *And when he had given thanks, he broke it and said,*

People: ***“This is my body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of me.”***

THE CUP

Pastor: *In the same way, after supper he took the cup, saying,*

People: ***“This cup is the new covenant in my blood; do this, whenever you drink it, in remembrance of me.”***

Pastor: *For whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord’s death until he comes.*
