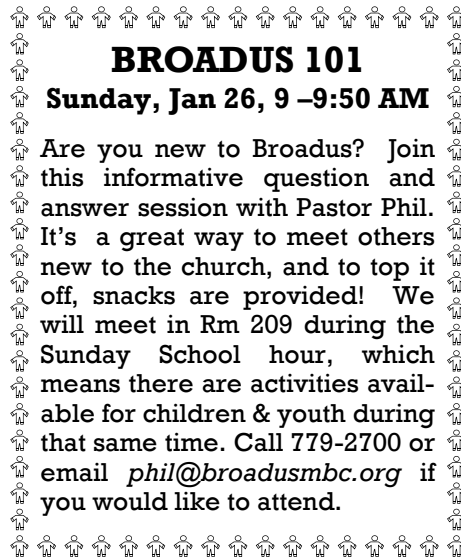

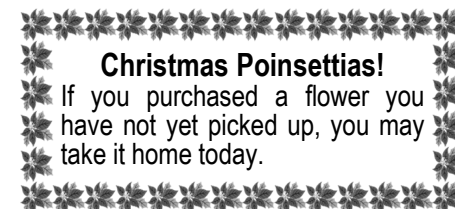
Guest Speaker
