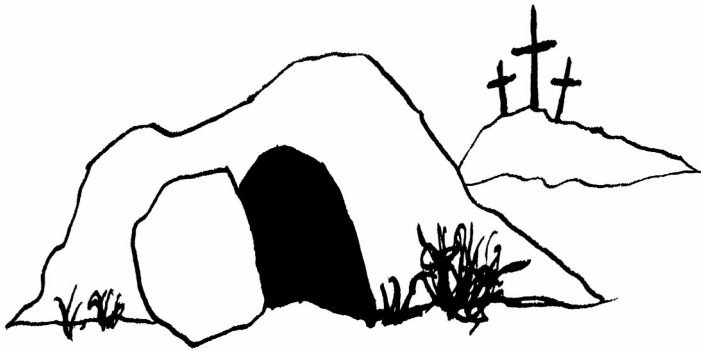

April 18 Good Friday

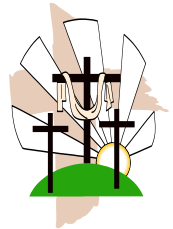
